


THE MAIN TRADING PARTNER OF LATVIA – THE EU COUNTRIES










EXPORTS AND IMPORTS OF LATVIAN GOODS TO CIS COUNTRIES, UKRAINE, AND GEORGIA






NATURAL GAS (IN GASEOUS STATE)










